I. <u>Process for Arriving at Scores</u>

The Scores are obtained by adopting the following procedure:

- Number of questions answered correctly by a candidate in each objective test is considered for arriving at the Corrected Score after applying penalty for wrong answers.
- (ii) The Corrected Scores so obtained by a candidate are made equivalent to take care of the minor difference in difficulty level, if any, in each of the objective tests held in different sessions to arrive at the <u>Equated Scores*</u>.
 - * Scores obtained by candidates on any test are equated to the base form by considering the distribution of scores of all the forms.
- (iii) Final scores in each test are rounded off to the nearest integer

Note: Cutoffs were applied in <u>two</u> stages:

- (i) on scores in individual tests
- (ii) on Total Score

The details of the cutoffs applied on Scores in individual tests and on Total Score is given below at (II) and (III) respectively.
