

A book on Chipko Movement by ShekharPathak bags KamaladeviChattopadhyay NIF Prize 2022

A book on the popular forest conservation campaign Chipko Movement, written by historian-activist ShekharPathak, was named the winner of the KamaladeviChattopadhyay NIF Book Prize 2022. Translated from Hindi by ManishaChaudhry, "The Chipko Movement: A

People's History" was selected from a diverse shortlist of five books covering a wide expanse of modern Indian history and encompassing distinct topics and perspectives.



The winner was selected by a six-member jury panel chaired by political scientist NirajaGopalJayal. The other jury members were entrepreneur Manish Sabharwal; historians SrinathRaghavan and Nayanj otLahiri; former diplomat NavtejSarna; and attorney Rahul Matthan.

NDTV Promoter Firm RRPR Holding Transfers 99.5% Shares to Adani's VCPL

- News Broadcaster New Delhi Television Ltd (NDTV) promoter firm RRPR Holding announced that it has transferred shares constituting 99.5 percent of its equity capital to Adani group-owned Vishvapradhan Commercial (VCPL). The transfer of shares will give Adani Group control over a 29.18 percent stake in NDTV. They are also open to offer for another 26 percent stake in the media film.
- **GautamAdani**, Chairman of the Adani Group has said that the NDTV purchase was a responsibility rather than a business opportunity.
- NDTV had said that VCPL has served notice on the broadcast based on a loan agreement it had entered into with its founders in 2009-2010.

India The First Country in The World to Receive \$100 billion in Remittances

• India will be the first country in the world to receive \$100 billion from remittances during 2022,

the World Bank has said. Though remittances to the rest of the South Asian countries declined by 10%, it rose by 12% in India's case.



- Remittances to **South Asian countries grew by 3.5%** to \$163 billion in 2022
- Though remittances to the rest of the South Asian countries declined by 10%, it rose by 12% in India's case.
- Worldwide, remittances are estimated at \$794 billion in 2022.
- South Asia receives the most remittances that are estimated at \$163 billion in 2022.
- India's share will be \$100 billion.
- Latin America and Caribbean comes second with \$142 billion.

Adani Green becomes World's Largest Wind-Solar Hybrid Power Developer

- Adani Green Energy Ltd (AGEL), the renewables arm of Adani Group, has commissioned its third windsolar hybrid power plant at Jaisalmer in Rajasthan. Earlier, in May 2022, AGEL had operationalised India's first hybrid power plant of 390 MW.
- This was followed by the commissioning, in September 2022, of the world's largest co-located hybrid power plant of 600 MW. Both these hybrid energy generation assets are located in Jaisalmer, Rajasthan. With the successful commissioning of this 450 MW plant, AGEL now has a total operational generation capacity of 7.17 GW. This also makes AGEL the world's largest wind-solar hybrid power farm developer.

India's 100 Richest 2022: GautamAdani tops Forbes rich list

 The world economy may be slowing but India's richest have grown even richer this year. The Forbes 2022 list of India's 100 richest is





- finally here, according to which, the combined wealth of India's 100 richest grew by \$25 billion to touch a colossal \$800 billion.
- \$385 billion. Adani Group chairman GautamAdani has bagged the top spot on the list with a net worth of \$150 billion. According to Forbes, the gain was largely due to a record-breaking feat by infrastructure tycoon, which changed the pecking order at the top for the first time since 2008.

Nagpur Metro successfully created a Guinness World Record

Nagpur Metro has successfully created a Guinness

World Record by constructing the longest double-decker viaduct (metro) is 3,140 meters and was achieved by the Wardha Road in Nagpur.



The double-decker viaduct

of 3.14 km on Wardha Road has three metro stations – Chhatrapati Nagar, Jai Prakash Nagar and Ujjwal Nagar. These stations require special planning which are station specific to meet the functional requirements of themetro duly incorporating site specific constraints and double-decker viaduct requirements. The engineering thought process, concept, design and execution of these stations are no less than a challenge.

IPL remains the most searched query on Google in India on 2022

• Google has released its "Year in Search 2022" report, which highlights the topics that generated the most interest and were most frequently searched on the website this year. India's search trends have changed

- The Indian Premier League (IPL), which was also the most searched sporting event in the nation, came out on top of all 2022 trending search results in India.

- The FIFA World Cup, which began on November 20 in Qatar, ranked third among trending topics in searches in India. Sports competitions, the Asia Cup and the ICC Men's T20 World Cup, respectively, took the fourth and fifth spots.

passport is a travel document issued by a country's government to its citizens that verifies the identity and nationality of the holder for the purpose of international travel. India was ranked at 87th position in the world's strongest passport list.

• The UAE has the strongest passport in the world. Holders of this passport can travel visa-free or "visa on arrival" to 180 countries. With a UAE passport travelers can enter to 180 countries hassle-free, seven more than European countries such as Germany and Sweden, and nine more than Japan, the index showed.

that Indian actor Dev Joshi, K-Pop star T.O.P. will be among the eight people who will join him on a flyby around the moon



on a SpaceX spaceship next year.

- The rocket that has been developed by **Elon Musk**'s SpaceX will make a week-long journey to the moon and back next year. Maezawa had in 2018 purchased all the eight seats aboard this rocket ship.
- Maezawa started taking application for the trip in March 2021. This will be Maezawa's second space journey after his 12-day trip to the International Space Station on the Soyuz Russian spaceship last year.

India, China troops clash along LAC in Tawang region, Arunachal Pradesh

• Indian and Chinese troops clashed along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in the Tawang sector of Arunachal Pradesh on December 9 and the face-

- off resulted in "minor injuries to a few personnel from both sides", the Indian Army said.
- The clash near Yangtse along the LAC in the sensitive sector took place amid the over 30-month border standoff between the two sides in eastern Ladakh.
- It is the first major clash between the Indian and Chinese armies since August 2020 near Rinchen La in eastern Ladakh. Indian and Chinese troops were engaged in a brief face-off near Yangtse in October last year as well and it was resolved following talks between local commanders of the two sides as per established protocols.

BJP's Bhupendra Patel sworn-in as Gujarat CM for 2nd consecutive term

- Bhupendra Patel took oath as the Chief Minister of Gujarat for a second straight term in Gandhinagar. He was administered oath as the 18th Chief Minister of Gujarat by Governor AcharyaDevvrat.
- Patel was sworn in as the 17th Chief Minister of Gujarat on September 13, 2021.
- Breaking his own record, Patel won the 2022 election once again from Ghatlodia constituency with a huge

NamamiGange was selected from over 150 such initiatives from 70 countries across the globe. They were selected under the banner of the United Nations Decade on Ecosystem Restoration, a global movement coordinated by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) and the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO).

It is designed to prevent and reverse the degradation of natural spaces across the planet. The recognized initiatives, including Namami Gange, will now be eligible to receive UN support, funding or technical expertise.

- Vijay Diwas is celebrated every year on 16th December to honour the victory of the Indian armed forces over Pakistan in 1971. Vijay Diwas is celebrated to commemorate the heroes who sacrificed their lives for the nation. The India-Pakistan war went on for 13 days and India defeated Pakistan on 16th December 1971.

Note in Circulation Rise 8% Annually to Rs 32 Lakh Crore: FM

• Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said note in

circulation (NiC) has witnessed an annual growth of 7.98 per cent to Rs 31.92 lakh crore as of December 2, 2022. The demand for currency depends



upon several macroeconomic factors, including economic growth and level of interest rates, she said.

Six years after demonetisation, the currency in circulation has jumped to a new high of Rs 32 lakh crore reflecting that cash still remains the preferred choice of payment for Indians. Compared with the predemonetisation period, it has increased by a massive 72 per cent from Rs 17 lakh crore on November 4, 2016.

IPL surpasses \$10 billion valuation and becomes decacorn

• IPL surpasses \$10 billion valuation: The Indian Premier League (IPL), whose total valuation has



surpassed \$10 billion, has evolved into a decacorn. A D and P Advisory report made public on Tuesday states that the league is currently worth \$10.9 billion. Notably, it has shown a startling 75% rise since 2020.

- IPL's expansion has been aided by lucrative agreements with industry titans in media.
- A company valued at more than \$10.0 billion is referred to as a decacorn.
- In less than 15 years since its beginning, the IPL has reached the milestone.
- Months after India won the first ICC T20 World Cup, the competition's first edition was contested in 2008.
- Since then, the IPL has become steadily stronger with well-known athletes from all over the world taking part.

underkm construction Banihal-Katra railway line in Jammu and Kashmir was completed by the Indian Railways.

The longest tunnel is part of the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Railway Line (USBRL) project. This is the fourth tunnel on the Banihal-Katra route following the 12.75 km tunnel T-49, the longest tunnel of the Indian Railways, which was completed in January this year.

Indian Billionaire Gautam Adani to Control Nearly 65% of NDTV

- Indian Billionaire Gautam Adani is to control 64.71% of New Delhi Television Ltd (NDTV) as the founders have decided to sell most of the shares.
- The founders of NDTV, Prannoy Roy and his wife Radhika Roy have decided to transfer most of the shares in the company giving Gautam Adani his conglomerate control of about 65% of NDTV. The decision comes after four months after Gautam Adani announced his takeover of the news channel.

first complete Dharmadam becomes library constituency in India

Minister Pinaravi Kerala Chief Vijavan's

constituency has achieved a new record recently. It has become the only constituency in India to have a library in all the wards.



- CM Vijayan's constituency **Dharmadam** has achieved the position of complete library constituency in India, the first in India. Out of the total 138 wards in the constituency, there were no libraries in 63 wards. Dharmadam reached the achievement with the opening of libraries in these wards too.
- Kerala which was the first state to achieve 100% literacy status in India is also perhaps the only state in India that has a library in every village.
- Puthuvayil Narayana Panicker of Kerala is also known as the Father of the Library Movement in India. He started Granthashala Sangam with about 50 small libraries in 1945 in Kerala which grew into a large network of thousands of libraries.
- To honour and acknowledge P.N.Panicker ,Kerala Government declared June 19, his death anniversary, as Vayanadinam (Reading Day) in 1996 In 2017, Prime Minister Narendra Modi declared June 19 his death anniversary as National Reading Day in India. The following month is also observed as National Reading Month in India.





World Economy Seems Headed For A Recession, **Compounded With Inflation**

The global economy seems headed for a severe recession and parallels are being drawn with

the global financial crisis of 2008 and the slowdown brought about in 2020 by the Covid-19 pandemic. A lot of hope that any serious setback can



be averted rests on a high degree of fine tuning of policy which may be difficult to deliver.

The US dollar has been surging for the past few months. It's now the strongest it has been in two

decades, and experts believe the value will grow even stronger in the coming days. But this surge in the value of the power of the greenback is agitating the economies and markets worldwide, and creating winners and losers.

Though a strong dollar bodes well for the Americans, the consequences are faced by other countries, especially the developing ones. The rise of US dollar has led to a decline in the value of UK pound, the euro, China's yuan, Japan's yen, India's rupee and many others. As a result, it makes it more expensive for these nations to import essential items like food and fuel.

US prints first banknotes with women's signatures

The U.S. The Treasury (United States of America's Finance Ministry) has printed the first US banknotes

(currency notes) with two women's signatures.

The new currency notes of \$1 and \$5 value carry the signature of the

In the United States the currency notes are printed by the Treasury Department's Bureau of Engraving and Printing and the Federal Reserve decides how much currency notes will be printed. The Treasury Department's Bureau of Engraving and Printing has note printing facilities at Fort Worth, Texas and another in Washington.

Russia Replaces Iraq as Top Oil Supplier to India in November

Russia has for the first time emerged as top oil supplier **India** replacing Iraq as refiners last month snapped up oil from Moscow fearing a price cap from Dec. 5 could hit supplies and choke





payment avenues.

- India's oil imports from Russia rose for the fifth straight month, totaling 908,000 barrels per day (bpd) in November, up 4% from October, the data showed. The Group of Seven nations(G-7), Australia, and the 27 European Union countries have imposed a price cap of \$60 a barrel on Russian seaborne oil from Dec. 5 as the West tries to limit Moscow's ability to finance its war in Ukraine.
- The price cap plan calls for G7 countries to deny insurance, finance, brokering, navigation, and other services to oil cargoes priced above the price cap on crude and oil products.

New Zealand govt passes world's first tobacco law to ban smoking

 The New Zealand government has passed a law to completely end tobacco smoking by banning youth

from buying cigarettes for life.

The Smoke Free Environments and Regulated Products (Smoking Tobacco) Amendment



Bill has been passed in New Zealand which aims to make New Zealand smoke free by 2025.

- The bill aims to ban the sale of tobacco to anyone born after **January 1**, **200**9, and reduce the number of cigarette retailers in the country.
- The bill has received bipartisan support in New Zealand's parliament and Prime Minister **JacindaArdern** also plans to reduce the amount of nicotine allowed in smokeless tobacco products. Passage of the bill would reduce the number of tobacco retailers nationwide to about one-tenth of the current number of 6,000.

Iran Removed From UN Commission on the Status of Women

• Iran has been expelled from the United Nation's Commission on the Status of Women (UNW) in a

vote on which India abstained. The US proposal at the UN Economic and Social Council to remove Iran from the panel received 29 votes, while there



were eight votes against and 16 abstentions in the 54-member elected body.

- Mahsa Amin who died after being held by "morality police" in September. Her death sparked the protests, during which, "government security forces have reportedly detained and tortured thousands of people, killed hundreds of peaceful protestors, and badly injured many more. Men supporting women in the streets are now being targeted with the death penalty.
- The UN Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) was established in 1946, and has become instrumental in promoting women's rights, documenting the reality of women's lives throughout the world, and shaping global standards on gender equality and the empowerment of women. Its 45 members are elected by ECOSOC, based on equitable geographical distribution, and serve for four years.



UNSC Adopts First-ever Resolution on Myanmar

• The U.N. Security Council has adopted its first ever resolution on Myanmar in 74 years to demand an end

to violence and urge the military junta to release all political prisoners, including ousted leader Aung San Suu Kyi. Ms. Kyi, 77, has been a



prisoner since the army toppled her government almost two years ago and violently cracked down on dissent.

 The 15-member council has long been split on how to deal with the Myanmar crisis with China and Russia arguing against strong action. They both **abstained** from the vote, along with **India**. The remaining 12 members voted in favor.

- The next-generation stealth bomber was rolled out at arm's manufacturer Northrop Grumman's facility in California. The US Air Force plans to buy at least 100 of the B-21 aircraft, which comes with a \$700m price tag per plane.
- The unveiling of the new bombers comes at a time of heightened geopolitical tensions between the US, Russia and China amid the war in Ukraine and the territorial integrity of Taiwan.

India received Rafale's 36th and last aircraft from France

All 36 Rafale aircraft were delivered to India by France. India and France struck an intergovernmental agreement wherein Paris committed to pay India 60,000 crore rupees for 36 Rafale fighter jets in



- The Rafale is a 4.5 generation jet with long-range airto-air and air-to-ground missiles, as well as cuttingedge radar and electronic warfare capabilities.
- The aircraft's serviceability is over 75%, and the French company Dassault Aviation is also involved in its maintenance.

At the height of the war with China, the Rafale entered the Indian Air Force quickly and began flying over Ladakh a week after arriving.



• Olympic medalist shooter Gagan Narang and Rowing Federation of India president Rajlaxmi Singh Deo have been elected unopposed as vice presidents. Indian Weightlifting Federation (IWF) president Sahdev Yadav has been elected the treasurer. All India Football Federation (AIFF) president and former goalkeeper Kalyan Chaubey has been elected unopposed as the joint secretary (male).

- Varadkar's rise to the top of Irish politics was remarkable in a country dominated by a strict, conservative Catholic morality well into the latter half of the last century. At 38, he became the country's youngest Taoiseach as well as its first openly gay head of government and first of Indian heritage.
- Varadkar was born in Dublin to an Irish mother who worked as a nurse and an Indian immigrant father, who was a qualified doctor.



Brazil World Cup winner and football legend, Pele passes away

football legend Edson Brazilian Arantes Nascimento, famously called Pelé, has passed away

aged 82. He is considered by many as one of greatest the footballers of all time.



He was instrumental in

> Brazil's three World Cup victories in 1958, 1962, and 1970. He is still the top scorer for Brazil national team with 77 goals in 92 games.

- He retired from Santos in 1974 but a year later made a surprise comeback by signing a lucrative deal to join the New York Cosmos in the then nascent North American Soccer League.
- In a glorious 21-year career he scored between 1,281 and 1,283 goals, depending on how matches are counted. Pele, though, transcended soccer, like no player before or since, and he became one of the first global icons of the 20th century.
- During his career, he became known as "The Black Pearl".

Pele was named "Athlete of the Century" by the International Olympic Committee, co-"Football Player of the Century" by world soccer body FIFA, and a "national treasure" by Brazil's government.

- BR Ambedkar, the father of the Indian Constitution, was born on April 14, 1891. Fondly known as Babasaheb, he fought for the economic and social empowerment of Dalits in the country, eradicating the social scourge of untouchability and promoting gender equality. He was also among the seven members of the drafting committee who prepared a draft of the Constitution of independent India.
- In 1990, the Bharat Ratna, India's highest civilian award, was posthumously conferred on Ambedkar. The salutation Jai Bhim used by followers honours him. He is also referred to by the honorific Babasaheb, meaning "Respected Father".

National Armed Forces Flag Day 2022: 7th December

Every year on December 7, India commemorates

- The campaign will be centred around the theme, "Dignity, Freedom, and Justice for All."

UNICEF Day observed on 11 December


- Every year UNICEF Day is celebrated on December 11 every year.

- The day was announced on 26 February 2012 by the then **Prime Minister Manmohan Singh** to mark the 125th anniversary of the birth of the Indian mathematical genius Srinivasa Ramanujan (22 Dec 1887- 26 Apr 1920). **2012 was also observed as National Mathematics Year.**

- In 1998–1999, he was elected prime minister for a second term. On October 13, 1999, he was elected as the nation's prime minister for the third time.
- Significantly, former prime minister Atal Vihari Vajpayee was the first head of state to address the UN in Hindi
- The "Bharat Ratna" award was given to him on March 27, 2015.
