Kerala leads in hosting legislative sessions in 2021

Kerala, which dropped to eighth place in terms of

Assembly convening the sessions during initial COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, regained first place in 2021 with the nation's longest House session at 61 days.



- The PRS Legislative Research, a think tank with its headquarters in New Delhi, published the research on the operation of State Assemblies for 2021.
- Karnataka came in second with 40 sitting days, followed by Tamil Nadu with 34, and Odisha with 43.
- The guidelines for how legislatures should operate were set forth by the National Commission to Review the Working of the Constitution (2000-2002), which was presided over by former Chief Justice of India M.N. Venkatachaliah.
- The Houses of State/UT legislatures should convene for at least 50 days a year for those with fewer than 70 members, like Puducherry, and at least 90 days for those with more members.

Indian Women Savitri Jindal replaces China's Yang Huiyan to become Asia's Richest Woman Savitri Jindal, the Chairperson Emeritus of **OP**

Group, has Jindal surpassed China's Yang Huiyan to become Asia's richest woman, as per the real-time **Bloomberg** Billionaires Index. The 72-year-old Savitri Jindal



who also holds the position of the richest woman in India has a total fortune of \$11.3 billion.

The fortune of Yang Huiyan, owner of China's largest real estate developer 'Country Garden Holdings', dropped by more than half in 2022, from \$ 24 billion to \$11 billion. She had been Asia's richest woman for the past five years.

NSE and BSE approve of Zee's merger with Sony Pictures

- The BSE and NSE stock exchanges have given Zee Entertainment their approval for Zee Entertainment's proposed merger with Sony Pictures Networks India.
- According to a statement by Zee Entertainment Enterprises Ltd., both the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) and the National Stock Exchange (NSE) have accepted the planned merger with Culver Max Entertainment Private Limited (formerly Sony Pictures Networks India).
- The stock exchanges' approval is a decisive and encouraging step in the merger approval process as a whole.

Jio getting ready to launch World's Most Advanced **5G Network across India**

- Reliance Jio, owned by billionaire MukeshAmbani, became the highest bidder for 5G spectrum, paying Rs 88,078 crore to buy over half of the airwaves offered in the most recent auction.
- The Adani group paid Rs 212 crore for 400 MHz, or less than 1% of all spectrum sold, according to Telecom Minister AshwiniVaishnaw. Jio has also acquired the 700 MHz band.
- While Jio purchased spectrum across several bands, including the coveted 700 MHz band, which can provide 6-10 km of signal range and serves as a good foundation for fifth generation (5G) in all 22 circles in the country.
- Adani Group purchased spectrum in the 26 GHz band, which is not for public networks.

If 700 Mhz is used, a single towner can cover a larger • area.

Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora. The RajyaSabha still needs to pass the Bill, though.

- According to BhupenderYadav, the Union Environment Minister, the government operates under the VasudhaivaKutumbakam principle and strives to improve both humankind and all other animal species.
- The Union Environment Minister has also urged people to avoid purchasing upscale goods derived from animals from threatened or endangered species.

Fortune Global 500 list: LIC breaks into Fortune 500 list

- Indian statutory insurance and investment corporation, Life Insurance Corporation (LIC) has broken into the latest Fortune Global 500 list.
- The nation's biggest life insurer with revenue of USD 97.26 billion and a profit of USD 553.8 million, was ranked 98th on the just released Fortune 500 list. This is the first outing of LIC on the list, which ranks listed companies by sales.

India's Trade Deficit At Record High: 31 billion Dollar

India's trade deficit widened to a record \$31.02 billion in July, as imports of goods surged despite

bivalent ModernaCovid booster vaccination. Covid booster vaccination targets both the original strain of COVID-19 and the more recent Omicron version.



YB Centre in south Mumbai. The name of the bus is "Switch EiV 22", the double-decker bus will be run by the Mumbai civic transport body from September.

• NitinGadkari said 35 per cent of the pollution is because of diesel and petrol, and the introduction of these buses will reduce pollution. Two new electric buses, including the first air-conditioned doubledecker bus in the country, will join the fleet of the Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport (BEST).

Vistara emerges second largest domestic airline by market share

• Full-service Vistara emerged as the second biggest

airline by domestic market share last month with a **10.4% pie of the sky**, distantly second to the market leader **IndiGo at 58.8%**.



The airline is Tata Sons'

joint venture with Singapore Airlines. The number three, four and five positions saw airlines separated by just decimal points — Air India (8.4%), GoFirst (8.2%) and SpiceJet (8%).

India's airlines carried 9.7 million passengers on domestic routes in July, almost double from a year earlier but lower than the 10.5 million passengers ferried in June 2022.

Goodfellows, senior-focused startup launched by Ratan Tata

- Ratan Tata, a pioneer in the field, unveiled **Goodfellows**, a firm that offers senior folks companionship services. Ratan Tata, the Chairman Emeritus of Tata Sons, provided seed money for the platform in an unknown amount.
- **Goodfellows** completed a successful beta test over the past six months, and the service is now available in Mumbai. Pune, Chennai, and Bangalore are the next target cities.
- Over 800 young graduates applied to work at Goodfellows during the beta testing phase, and 20 of those candidates were chosen to provide companionship to the elderly in Mumbai, according to the company.

GoI grants GI Tag to Bihar's MithilaMakhana

- The Central government has awarded Geographical Indication (GI) tag to MithilaMakhana. With this
 - move, growers will get the maximum price for their premium produce.



• Over five lakh farmers of the Mithila region of Bihar will

be benefitted from this decision. Makhana registered with GI Tag, farmers will get profit and it will be easier to earn.

- Once a product gets this tag, any person or company cannot sell a similar item under that name. This tag is valid for a period of 10 years following which it can be renewed.
- The other benefits of GI registration include legal protection to that item, prevention against unauthorised use by others, and promotion of exports.

Super Vasuki: Indian Railways longest freight train

- The Indian Railways conducted a test run of its latest train called Super Vasuki. The Super Vasuki is operated by the South East Central Railway (SECR) zone of the Indian Railways.
- The SECR ran the record long-haul freight trains Vasuki and Trishul last year and the 2.8 km long SheshNaag train before that. The Super Vasuki was set up by amalgamating five rakes of goods trains as one unit. The freight train is 3.5 km long.

Punjab & Haryana agree to be name Chandigarh airport after Bhagat Singh

- The Punjab and Haryana governments have agreed to name the Chandigarh International Airport in Mohali after ShaheedBhagat Singh. The decision was taken during a meeting between Punjab CM Bhagwant Mann & Haryana deputy CM DushyantChautala.
- The Punjab government has already declared a state holiday on March 23, the martyrdom day of legendary freedom fighter Bhagat Singh.
- The Rs 485-crore airport project is a joint venture of the Airports Authority of India (AAI), the governments of Punjab and Haryana.

India's First Observatory To Monitor Space Activity To Come Up InUttarakhand

- India's first commercial space situational awareness observatory, to track objects as small as 10 cm in size orbiting the earth, will be set up in the Garhwal region of Uttarakhand by Digantara, a space sector start-up.
- The space situational awareness (SSA) observatory will help India track any activity in space including that of space debris and military satellites hovering over the region.
- Currently, the United States is a dominant player in monitoring space debris with observatories in multiple locations and commercial companies providing additional inputs from across the world.

UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage List: India nominated Garba

• India has nominated the Indian dance form Garba to

be inscribed on UNESCO's intangible cultural heritage list. Last year, Durga Puja was included in UNESCO's intangible



UNESCO's intangible cultural heritage list and for 2022, India has nominated 'Garba'. The next **UNESCO** meeting will be held in November.

• In July, India was elected by UNESCO to serve on the distinguished intergovernmental Committee of the 2003 Convention for the safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage. A total of **14 elements from**

India are inscribed on UNESCO'S list of Intangible Cultural Heritage and Humanity. These elements include music, dance, theatre, festivals, rituals, and storytelling.

World's first fleet of hydrogen passenger trains by Germany

- The world's first fleet of hydrogen-powered passenger trains was launched by Germany. The first fleet of hydrogen-powered passenger trains has replaced 15 diesel trains that were previously operated on nonelectrified tracks in Lower Saxony, Germany. The engine of the trains is powered by electricity generated using hydrogen fuel cells.
- These trains have ranges up to 1000 kilometers and a maximum speed of 140 kph. After the introduction of the first fleet of hydrogen-powered passenger trains, the hydrogen produced with renewable energy the trains will save up to **1.6 liters of diesel in a year**.
- For now, hydrogen is produced as a byproduct of chemical processes, however, the German Specialty Gas Company Linde, plans to manufacture hydrogen using only renewable energy in the coming years.

Nagaland gets its 2nd railway station in 119 years

North-east state, Nagaland got its second railway

station after a gap of more than **119 years** with the commissioning of a new facility



at Shokhuvi. **Dimapur Railway Station**, in the heart of the commercial hub of the state, was inaugurated in 1903.

- Chief Minister **Neiphiu Rio** flagged off the DonyiPolo Express from Shokhuvi Railway Station during the day.
- The Donyi Polo Express ran daily between Guwahati in Assam and Naharlagun in Arunachal Pradesh. The train service has now been extended till Shokhuvi, a few kilometres from Dimapur. Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh will be directly connected by train service with the extension of Donyi Polo Express till Shokhuvi Railway Station.





ViratKohli becomes 1st Indian to play 100 Matches in each format

• Cricket Legend ViratKohli has become the first Indian and just the second player overall in international cricket history to have played 100 matches each in all three formats of the game. He added another milestone to his name when he was named in India's playing XI for the highly anticipated Asia Cup 2022 match with Pakistan.

Kohli has now 100 T20Is to his name in addition to 102 Tests and 262 ODIs since making his international debut in August 2008. His best individual score for India in this format is 94 and he has scored 30 half-centuries in this format. Kohli has an incredible record in T20I cricket for Team India having scored 3308 runs at an incredible average of 50.1.
