RBI Imposes Major Restrictions On Paytm Payments Bank: Operations Limited Post-February 29

- In a significant move, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has imposed major business restrictions on Paytm Payments Bank, effective from February 29.
- The RBI directive prohibits Paytm Payments Bank from accepting fresh deposits, credit transactions, or



- top-ups in customer accounts, including prepaid instruments such as wallets and FASTags, after February 29.
- While the Paytm app is expected to continue normal operations, services linked to the Paytm Bank will only be available until February 29 or until the exhaustion of the available balance.
- The nodal accounts of Paytm's parent company, One97 Communications Ltd., and Paytm Payments Bank Ltd., have been terminated by the central bank as part of the regulatory measures.

- The Indian government provided ₹6,541.79 crore to foreign governments with ₹4,927.43 crore as a grant and ₹1,614.36 crore as a loan, as per the revised estimates for 2023-24. It crossed the budget estimates of ₹5,848.58 crore for 2023-24.

RBI Announces: 97.50% Of Rs 2,000 Notes Returned To System

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) revealed on February 1 that 97.50% of the Rs 2,000 currency notes in circulation as of May 19, 2023, have been successfully reintegrated into the banking system.
- The total value of Rs 2,000 banknotes in circulation decreased from Rs 3.56 lakh crore on May 19, 2023, to Rs 8,897 crore by January 31, 2024.
- The Rs 2,000 banknotes were introduced in **November 2016** to address the urgent currency requirements after the withdrawal of Rs 500 and Rs 1,000 notes. Printing of Rs 2,000 notes ceased in 2018-19 once an ample supply of other denominations became available. Despite this, Rs 2,000 notes remain legal tender, as confirmed by the RBI.

Uttarakhand Cabinet Approves Uniform Civil Code Bill: Tabled In Assembly On Feb 6




